Parish President Aaron Broussard advises that re-entry to Jefferson Parish will end at 6:00 pm each day for as long as the Parish is under Martial Law, which will be at least one month.

Due to the curfew in effect, cars arriving in the re-entry line after 6:00 pm will not be allowed to enter. You will have to turn back. It will not be safe for you to violate curfew. So don't try.

Additionally, no cars will be allowed in Jefferson Parish on any day past 6:00 pm for the next month, as long as Martial Law is in effect.

We are very happy that one thousand troops of the Army National Guard will arrive on Monday in Jefferson Parish and will be immediately deployed to assist Jefferson Parish/City and State Law Enforcement officers to help to continue our security efforts throughout our Parish and municipalities as our citizens return.
