Garbage, Food Waste, and Storm Debris

Garbage, food waste and storm debris may be dropped off at the Jefferson Parish Landfill at 5800 Highway 90 West in Waggaman which is open for business, Monday through Saturday from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. There is no charge to Jefferson Parish residents only (proof of residency required). Businesses and contractors will be charged a fee of \$28 per ton until further notice.
