## ***GARBAGE & TRASH DROP OFF SITES***

Jefferson Parish Emergency Managers have released the following as it pertains to the aftermath of Hurricane Rita:

### **GARBAGE AND TRASH DROP-OFF SITES**

For those residents wanting to dispose of garbage and storm debris between scheduled curbside collections, Jefferson Parish is re-opening the following two trash drop-off sites beginning Monday, September 26<sup>th</sup>. The sites will be open daily from 9 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. until further notice.

- 400 David Drive in Metairie (between Airline Drive and West Metairie Avenue)
- 6250 Lapalco Boulevard in Marrero (west of Ames Boulevard)

The following wastes will be accepted at these locations:

- Food wastes
- Tree debris/vegetation
- Construction and demolition debris
- White goods (appliances) except refrigerators and air conditioners. *Refrigerators and air conditioners require freon extracted, therefore, these appliances will not be accepted at the above drop-off sites but can be brought to the Jefferson Parish Sanitary Landfill at 5800 Highway 90 West in Waggaman.*

Additionally, the two *temporary* trash drop-off sites located at 3769 West Metairie Avenue in Metairie and 5990 Lapalco Boulevard in Marrero *will be closed effective Monday, September 26, 2005.*
