JEFFERSON PARISH RECOGNIZES ITS SENIOR VOLUNTEERS

Jefferson Community Action Programs (JeffCAP) will honor its senior volunteers at the Best Western Landmark Hotel, 2601 Severn Avenue, Metairie on Thursday, September 16, 201 from noon to 2:30 p.m. at our **30TH ANNUAL JEFFCAP RETIRED SENIORS VOLUNTEER PROGRAM (RSVP) LUNCHEON.**

This years' theme is “**CELEBRATING PEOPLE IN ACTION.**” The luncheon will feature keynote speaker Sally Ann Roberts, WWL TV's morning news anchor and will honor the RSVP volunteers who have given outstanding service during the 2009-2010 program year.

The program has grown to more than 800 volunteers, making it one of the largest programs in Louisiana. JeffCAP RSVP volunteers serve in 26 nonprofit organizations and other agencies throughout Jefferson Parish.

Since July 2009, all RSVP volunteers have devoted 170,000 hours of service to the Jefferson Parish communities. They have varied tasks from assisting at community centers, day care centers for children and adults, tutoring, serving at nutrition centers, hospitals, museums, libraries and law enforcement agencies.

Volunteers serve without pay, and there are no educational or income requirements to join. The only requirements are to be age 55 and older and have a willingness to serve.
