AERIAL SPRAYING FOR MOSQUITOES

Aerial spraying is scheduled in parts of Jefferson Parish and will take place on the evening of Sunday, August 22, 2010 weather conditions permitting. Spraying will begin approximately 7:40 p.m. and end at approximately 9:40 p.m. The boundaries to be sprayed are as follows:

- ◆ Spraying will take place in the vicinity of River Ridge/Harahan in the area bounded by Airline Drive on the north, the Mississippi River on the south, Little Farms Avenue on the west, and Hickory Drive on the east.
- ◆ Spraying will take place in the vicinity of the Town of Jean Lafitte in the area bounded by Highway 45 (Jean Lafitte Boulevard) on the north, Kenal Road on the south, Highway 301 (Privateer Boulevard) on the west, and Highway 45 (Jean Lafitte Boulevard) on the east.
- ◆ Spraying will take place in the vicinity of Crown Point in the area bounded by Highway 45 (Barataria Boulevard) on the north, Highway 303 (Jean Lafitte Blvd) on the south, Highway 3134 (Leo Kerner Parkway formerly Lafitte-Larose Hwy.) on the west, and Highway 45 (Barataria Boulevard) on the east.

If weather conditions on the evening of August 22nd force the cancellation of the scheduled flight, aerial spraying will take place on the first subsequent evening on which weather conditions permit.
