BONNABEL BOAT LAUNCH TO CLOSE FOR A BRIEF TIME

As the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers continues work on the 100-year flood protection plan on the Bonnabel Boulevard Flood Project, the Bonnabel Boat Launch will be closed from 3 p.m. on Thursday, August 19 to 6 a.m. on Friday, August 20.

The closure is necessary for Barriere Construction to install the final layer of asphalt through the flood gates to the parking lot and on the bike path.

To give the public ample time to exit the Bonnabel Boat Launch, northbound traffic entering the launch will be shutdown at 3 p.m. and the southbound traffic exiting the launch will be shutdown at 5 p.m. on Thursday, August 19.

The total cost for this project is estimated at \$3 million.

This work is expected to be completed on Friday, August 20 at 6 a.m., weather permitting.
