### AERIAL SPRAYING FOR MOSQUITOES

Aerial spraying in response to nuisance mosquito activity is scheduled to take place on the East and West Banks of Jefferson Parish on the evening of Friday, August 13, 2010, weather conditions permitting.

Low-level aerial spraying will take place from 7:40 p.m. to 9:40 p.m. The areas to be sprayed are as follows:

- **RIVER RIDGE - HARAHAH AREA:** bounded by Airline Drive on the north, the Mississippi River on the south, Hickory Avenue on the east and Little Farms Avenue on the west.
- **KENNER AREA:** bounded by Lake Pontchartrain on the north, the Mississippi River on the south, Williams Boulevard on the east and the Jefferson/St. Charles Parish line on the west.
- **MARRERO AREA:** bounded by Tusa Drive on the north, Jean Lafitte National Park on the south, Leo Kerner Lafitte Parkway on the east and Baratavia Boulevard on the west.

If weather conditions on the evening of August 13, 2010 force the cancellation of the scheduled flights, aerial spraying will take place on the first subsequent evening on which weather conditions permit.
