LANE CLOSURES

LAPALCO BOULEVARD AND MANHATTAN BOULEVARD

On Sunday, September 26, 2010 from 7 a.m. to 3 p.m. the east and west bound left turn lanes of Lapalco Boulevard at the intersection of Manhattan Boulevard will close.

During the lane closures the intersection will be controlled by stop signs and JPSO deputies. Motorists wishing to turn left should travel to the nearest u-turn in each direction.

The lane closures are necessary for traffic signal conduit repair. The work will be performed by the Jefferson Parish Public Works Department at a cost of \$500 dollars.

The work is expected to be completed on September 26, 2010, weather permitting.
