AERIAL SPRAYING FOR MOSQUITOES

Aerial spraying is scheduled for parts of Jefferson Parish on the evening of Monday, September 20, 2010, weather conditions permitting. Spraying will begin at approximately 7:20 p.m. and end at approximately 9:20 p.m. The boundaries to be sprayed are:

- In Kenner in the area bounded by Lake Pontchartrain on the north, the Mississippi River on the south, Williams Boulevard on the east, and the St. Charles Parish line on the west.
- In the vicinity of Gretna/Harvey in the area bounded by the Mississippi River on the north, the West Bank Expressway on the south, the Harvey Canal on the west, and the Orleans Parish Line on the east.

If weather conditions on the evening of September 20th force the cancellation of the scheduled flight, aerial spraying will take place on the first subsequent evening on which weather conditions permit.
