### JEFFERSON PARISH OFFICES TO CLOSE AT 3 P.M. ON THURSDAY, SEPT 9

Most Jefferson Parish Government employees will be allowed to knock off work at 3 p.m. on Thursday, September 9, to allow them to attend the New Orleans Saints Season Opener and pre-game championship celebrations. However, normal services to the public will be provided, including Transit, Library and Recreation Department activities. Additionally, all essential employees will be required to report to work at their respective job sites in the event of an emergency, such as a rain event, etc.
