### GROUNDBREAKING CEREMONY

#### ***BUCKTOWN HARBOR IMPROVEMENTS***

(Hammond Highway, Bucktown, left of the Coast Guard Station)

Jefferson Parish Officials will hold a ceremony Wednesday, November 10, 2010 at 9:30 a.m., to mark the start of Phase I of the Bucktown Harbor Improvements.

Phase I will bring water, sewer, and electric service to the site, will construct an entrance road and parking area with associated drainage, landscaping, and lighting, and will install two floating piers with 70 boat slips. Future phases to complete the marina will include picnic shelters, walkways, shore overlooks, a fishing pier, a harbor master, additional parking, and six piers with 254 boat slips.

Advance Quality Construction, Inc. will perform the Phase I work at an estimated total cost of \$3,267,386. Construction is expected to take approximately 8 months to complete.
