PARISH PRESIDENT ANNOUNCES NEW APPOINTMENTS

Jefferson Parish President John F. Young, Jr., announced today the appointments of three new members of his Administration.

Heather M. Hilliard has been appointed as Chief Administrative Assistant for Jefferson Parish Public Safety Operations. Ms. Hilliard will oversee the Departments of Emergency Management, Community Justice Agency, Office of Juvenile Services, Eastbank Consolidated Fire Department, Environmental Affairs, and 911 Telecommunications.

Ms. Hilliard is an international Certified Emergency Manager (CEM) and a certified Louisiana Emergency Manager (LEM) with over a decade of experience in operations management and is experienced in counterterrorism planning and tactics and disaster response.

Having recently served as a statewide planner in emergency preparedness and as Program Monitor in Bioterrorism, Ms. Hilliard is currently Adjunct Professor of Tulane University's School of Continuing Studies, Homeland Security.

Ms. Hilliard received a Master of Business Administration degree in Marketing and Strategic Planning and a Master of Health Administration degree from the University of Pittsburgh and received a Bachelor of Arts degree in Sociology at Tulane University.

Ms. Hilliard's annual salary is \$90,000.

Loren C. Marino has been promoted to the position of Jefferson Parish Chief Administrative Assistant and will oversee Inspection and Code Enforcement, Site Planning Review, Planning, Crime Prevention and Quality of Life Enforcement.

Ms. Marino will continue to serve as Jefferson Parish Interim Director of Inspection and Code Enforcement while Mr. Young narrows his selection of a new Director.

Ms. Marino served the people of Jefferson Parish as an Assistant Parish Attorney supervising Westbank Code Enforcement and Land Use litigation. She also was an Assistant District Attorney in 24th Judicial District Court in Jefferson Parish prosecuting all manners of felony cases.

She received her Juris Doctor at Tulane Law School and received a Bachelor of Arts in Economics from the University of Michigan.

“Ms. Marino is among the best and brightest already working to serve the people of Jefferson Parish, and I will continue to seek out those with a fresh perspective and a new approach to the way we do business in Jefferson Parish”, said Parish President John Young.

Ms. Marino’s annual salary is \$90,000.

Ronald E. Lampard has been appointed to the position of Director of Jefferson Parish Community Justice Agency and will manage the criminal justice programs for adults and juveniles in Jefferson Parish. Mr. Lampard will work toward a more efficient operation of existing services, development of new programs and better coordination of services aimed at reducing crime in our community.

Mr. Lampard received his Juris Doctor from Loyola Law School and received a Bachelor of Arts degree in Political Science at Tulane University.

He has served in all phases of the criminal justice system throughout his adult life, most recently as Clerk of Court at New Orleans Municipal Court. He also served as Judge Ad Hoc in New Orleans Municipal Court.

Mr. Lampard is a member of the Jefferson Bar Association and the Louisiana State Bar Association.

Mr. Lampard’s annual salary is \$85,000.

“These new appointments further demonstrate my commitment to finding the most talented and skilled individuals who are dedicated to improving the quality of life for the citizens of Jefferson Parish,” said Parish President John Young.
