AERIAL SPRAYING FOR MOSQUITOES

Aerial spraying in response to nuisance mosquito activity is scheduled to take place on the East Bank of Jefferson Parish on the evening of Thursday, July 1, 2010, weather conditions permitting.

Low-level aerial spraying will take place from 8 p.m. to 10:15 p.m. The areas to be sprayed are as follows:

- **METAIRIE ARES – IN THE VICINITY OF LAFRENIER PARK:** bounded by I-10 on the north, West Metairie Avenue on the south, Transcontinental Drive on the east and Mississippi Avenue on the west.
- **RIVER RIDGE - HARAHAN AREA:** bounded by Airline Drive on the north, the Mississippi River on the south, Hickory Drive on the east and Filmore Street on the west.

If weather conditions on the evening of July 1 force the cancellation of the scheduled flights, aerial spraying will take place on the first subsequent evening on which weather conditions permit.
