Jefferson Transit Service on Clearview Parkway Now Operating



Jefferson Parish has received federal funding through the FTA New Freedom Grant Program to operate the Clearview route.

The Clearview (E8) route will operate Monday through Friday between 6 a.m. and 6 p.m. The transit route will run on Clearview Parkway between East Jefferson General Hospital and Jefferson Highway and will connect with other JeT routes: Veterans (E1), Airport (E2), Kenner Local (E3), Causeway (E5), and Huey P. Long (W10).

The Clearview route also includes two loops off of Clearview Parkway, as follows:

1. From Clearview Parkway to West Napoleon Avenue, Transcontinental Drive, and Veterans Boulevard
2. From Clearview Parkway to Mounes Boulevard, Elmwood Park Boulevard, Citrus Avenue, and Edwards Avenue to Jefferson Highway.

With the added Clearview route, JeT will operate eleven (11) routes: six (6) East Bank routes and five (5) West Bank routes. The East Bank routes include Veterans (E1), Airport (E2), Kenner Local (E3), Metairie Road (E4), Causeway (E5), and Clearview (E8). The West Bank routes include Avondale (W1), West Bank Expressway (W2), Lapalco (W3), Terrytown (W8), and Huey P. Long (W10).
