FUNDS STILL AVAILABLE FOR SUBDIVISION GRANTS

The Parish of Jefferson, Jefferson Community Foundation, and JEDCO are offering \$40,000 in Subdivision Grants to encourage beautification of subdivision entrances and instill civic pride among our communities.

All Jefferson Parish subdivisions are eligible to apply for the grants. A grant can be used to improve the landscaping of subdivision entrance signs or entranceways. Work may not be located on private property.

Up to \$1,000 per subdivision is available. The \$40,000 still available is the total remaining from \$50,000 originally dedicated to fund subdivision grants, which began in September 2009. Jefferson Parish's two beautification groups, Jefferson Beautification Inc. and Friends of Jefferson the Beautiful, will administer these grants.
