JEFFERSON TRANSIT SCHEDULE CHANGES AND DETOURS FOR MARDI GRAS 2010.

Due to carnival parades, Jefferson Transit will make East and West Bank transit detours. For more schedule information you may go to: <http://www.jeffersontransit.org/pdf/eb2010mardigras.pdf>

East Bank:

- During all parades on Veterans Boulevard, the **E1 Veterans Route** will detour to I-10 between Clearview Parkway and City Park.
- The E1 Airport Route will travel to South Carrollton Avenue and Tulane Avenue only. There will be no downtown service and the last bus will be at South Carrollton Avenue and Tulane Avenue at 9:49 p.m.
- On the E3 Kenner Local Route on Jefferson Highway, the last bus will be at South Carrollton Avenue and Claiborne Avenue at 9:45 p.m.
 - **On Mardi Gras Day** there will be **no services** for the following **JeT Routes**:
 - **E1 Veterans Boulevard**
 - **E4 Metairie Road**
 - **E5 Causeway Boulevard**

West Bank:

- All routes will run a Saturday schedule on Mardi Gras Day.
- The **W2 Westbank Expressway** and **W3 Lapalco Routes** will take the elevated expressway from Terry Parkway to Manhattan Boulevard and then back to their regular routes.
- When parade routes block Poydras Avenue and the News Orleans CBD, JeT passengers will only be picked up at Loyola Avenue and Tulane Avenue.
