LANE CLOSURES NORTH CAUSEWAY BOULEVARD (At West Esplanade Avenue)

There will be several lane restrictions at the intersection of North Causeway Boulevard and West Esplanade Avenue on Saturday, March 6, 2010 starting at 6 a.m. and ending at 3 p.m.

- Starting at 6 a.m. and ending at 10 a.m., the two northbound right through lanes on North Causeway Boulevard, north and south of eastbound West Esplanade Avenue will close.
- Starting at 10 a.m. and ending at 3 p.m., the eastbound right through lane west of Causeway Boulevard and the northbound left turn lanes on Causeway Boulevard, south of West Esplanade Avenue will be closed.

The closures are necessary for traffic signal mast arm installations. All Star Electric Incorporation will perform the work at an estimated cost of \$120,305.

The project is expected to be completed on March 6, 2010, barring any unforeseen contractor delay and weather permitting.
