AERIAL SPRAYING FOR MOSQUITOES

Aerial spraying in response to nuisance mosquito activity is scheduled to take place in Jefferson Parish on the evening of Sunday, September 6th, over parts of the East and West Banks of Jefferson Parish, weather conditions permitting.

Low-level aerial spraying will take place from 7:20 p.m to 9:45 p.m. The boundaries to be sprayed are as follows:

- **KENNER AREA:** In the area bounded by Lake Pontchartrain on the north, Louis Armstrong International Airport on the south, Chateau Boulevard on the east and the St Charles Parish line on the west.
- **METAIRIE AREA:** In the area bounded by Lake Pontchartrain on the north, Airline Drive on the south, the Orleans Parish line on the east and Bonnabel Boulevard on the west.
- **OLD JEFFERSON AREA:** In the area bounded by Airline Drive on the north, the Mississippi River on the south, Causeway Boulevard on the east and South Clearview Parkway on the west.
- **RIVER RIDGE AREA:** In the area bounded by Airline Drive on the north, the Mississippi River on the south, Hickory Avenue on the east and Little Farms Avenue on the west.
- **GRETNA/HARVEY AREA:** In the area bounded by the Mississippi River on the north, the West Bank Expressway on the south, the Orleans Parish line on the east and Barataria Boulevard on the west.

If weather conditions on the evening of September 6 force the cancellation of the scheduled flights, aerial spraying will take place on the first subsequent evening on which weather conditions permit.
