EXECUTIVE ORDER
OF CURFEW**

EXECUTIVE ORDER ESTABLISHING A PARISHWIDE MANDATORY CURFEW FROM EIGHT O'CLOCK (8:00) P.M. TO SIX O'CLOCK (6:00) A.M. PURSUANT TO THE LOUISIANA HOMELAND SECURITY AND EMERGENCY ASSISTANCE AND DISASTER ACT, LA: R.S. 29:721 *ET SEQ.* DUE TO THE EFFECTS OF HURRICANE ISAAC.

WHEREAS, On August 26, 2012, Jefferson Parish President, John F. Young, Jr., declared a parish-wide state of emergency due to the effects of Hurricane Isaac; and

WHEREAS, As a result of the impact of Hurricane Isaac, John F. Young, Jr., as Parish President of Jefferson Parish, hereby invokes all rights and duties afforded him under Louisiana Revised Statute 29:721 *et seq.* and all other applicable statutes and regulations, until further notice; and

WHEREAS, The Jefferson Parish government, through John F. Young, Jr., is empowered to take all necessary measures to ensure the continued safety, health, and welfare of the citizens of Jefferson Parish, as per law; and

WHEREAS, The Louisiana Homeland Security and Emergency Assistance and Disaster Act, R.S. 29:721, *et seq.*, confers upon the Parish President of the Parish of Jefferson powers to deal with emergencies and disasters in order to ensure that preparations of this Parish will be adequate to deal with such emergencies or disasters in order to detect, prevent, prepare for, investigate, respond to, or recover from such events, and generally to preserve the lives and property of the people of Jefferson Parish; and

WHEREAS, The Parish President is empowered to take all necessary measures to ensure the continued safety, health, and welfare of the citizens of Jefferson Parish, as per law. Pursuant to LA R.S. 29:727(F) the Parish President is empowered to, "Control ingress and egress to and from the affected area, the movement of persons within the area, and the occupancy of the premises therein"; and

WHEREAS, A mandatory parish wide curfew from eight o'clock (8:00) p.m. to six o'clock (6:00) a.m. is necessary to ensure the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of Jefferson Parish; and


IT IS ORDERED that there be a mandatory parish wide curfew throughout Jefferson Parish from eight o'clock (8:00) p.m. to six o'clock (6:00) a.m. This order shall remain in place until rescinded by the Parish President; and

IT IS ORDERED that ingress and egress to and from and movement of persons during the above mentioned time period will be controlled; and

IT IS ORDERED that any person or entity who interrupts or interferes with this order, the control of the Parish and/or Parish President shall be prosecuted to the fullest extent of the law.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this Executive Order extends from Wednesday, August 29, 2012 through Tuesday, September 4, 2012, unless terminated earlier.


