




I never dreamed it would be me,

We only had those few short years.


The badge no longer on my chest,

- Honoring Harry Lee, sheriff from 1980-2007, for his distinguished career in public service and his dedication to the Parish




SHERIFF HARRY LEE



- Lee was the second –longest-serving sheriff of Jefferson Parish. Lee was elected seven consecutive times, and served as Sheriff until his death at the age of 75.
- Lee also served as a U.S. Magistrate, Parish Attorney, and Major General in the Louisiana Air National Guard
- Lee was one of the most respected public servants of his time
- He was known for his love of children, community, and carnival season.
