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# MILLAGE RENEWAL

## CONSOLIDATED SEWERAGE DISTRICT NO. 1

### RENEWAL OF MILLAGE OF 5 MILLS FOR 10 YEARS

The renewal of the Consolidated Sewerage District #1 millage applies to unincorporated Jefferson Parish and the Town of Jean Lafitte.

This millage renewal will generate an estimated \$12,306,043 for acquiring, constructing, improving, maintaining and operating sewerage works and facilities for the district.

- ✓ The current cost to residential properties of \$12.50 annually will continue for properties valued at \$100,000. (Residents with homestead exemption)

### THE RENEWAL OF 5 MILLS WILL CONTINUE:

- ✓ Replacement and upgrade of the sewer collection, transport and treatment facilities.
- ✓ Maintaining compliance with federal, state and local environmental regulations.
- ✓ Approximately one third of the Sewerage Department operation and maintenance budget.
- ✓ Operation, maintenance and upkeep of 6 wastewater treatment plants, over 500 lift stations, and approximately 1,400 miles of pipelines which transport and treat more than 57 Million gallons of wastewater every day.



## FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT NO. 5

### RENEWAL OF MILLAGE OF 20 MILLS FOR 10 YEARS

**The renewal of the Fire Protection District #5 millage would apply to the areas of Terrytown, Unincorporated Gretna, and Timberlane subdivision.**

The renewal will continue to support acquiring, constructing, improving, providing, maintaining or operating fire protection facilities and equipment for the district which presently maintains a Class 2 fire insurance rating.

- ✓ The current cost to residential properties of \$50.00 annually will continue for properties valued at \$100,000.00.
- ✓ The current cost to residential properties of \$150.00 annually will continue for properties valued at \$150,000.00.



## CONSOLIDATED WATERWORKS DISTRICT NO. 1

### RENEWAL OF MILLAGE OF 5 MILLS FOR 10 YEARS

The renewal of the millage for the Consolidated Waterworks District #1 applies to unincorporated Jefferson Parish and the incorporated areas of Harahan, Kenner, Jean Lafitte, and Grand Isle.

This millage renewal will generate an estimated \$12,000,000 for acquiring, constructing, improving, maintaining and waterworks facilities for the district.

This millage is the sole source of revenue for capital improvements to the Consolidated Waterworks District 1 (includes both East and West banks).

- ✓ The current cost to residential properties of \$12.50 annually will continue for properties valued at \$100,000. (Residents with homestead exemption)

### RENEWAL OF THE 5 MILLS WILL CONTINUE:

- ✓ Replacement and upgrade of water treatment facilities.
- ✓ Ability to purchase laboratory equipment used to monitor over 100 contaminants covered by the Safe Drinking Water Act (and amendments).
- ✓ Replacement and upgrade of water mains.
- ✓ Continued ability to produce sufficient water flows for fire protection.
