1. No confirmation of registrations sent. Report to class unless otherwise notified.
2. Classes that have not met minimum enrollment are subject to cancellation, you will be notified if cancelled.
3. Only paid participants allowed in class.
4. REFUNDS - No refunds given 3 working days before an activity begins. A service charge of 10% will be levied on all refunds. NO CASH refunds given - a check will be mailed within 4-5 weeks for those paid using cash or check; accounts will be credited if you paid using a card.
5. PAYMENTS must accompany the registrations. For mail-ins - make check or money order payable to JPRD. Discover, Visa, or MasterCard accepted online or in our office only.
6. \$25 NSF fee assessed on returned checks.





Must be requested, in writing, 10 working days in advance - \$20 fee charged.



Any function consuming alcohol or having a large number of people will be required to have a Jefferson Parish deputy on duty. Arrangements will be made at the time of the reservation.




