

Pre-registrations are required for most classes. Registrations posted on a first come, first serve basis. The main office is open Monday thru Friday from 8:00 am - 5:00 pm. Registration is taken at the main office during office hours at 6921 Saints Dr. in Metairie.

Some classes with special requirements are not available for online registration. For these classes, camps and programs please register by mail OR in person at our office.

Liability

Injuries are to be reported to the instructor and playground personnel as soon as possible. Medical reimbursements insurance has been incorporated into class fees, except in some programs, such as athletics, Golden Age, and Alternative Programs where participants pay a medical reimbursement insurance fee before participating.

Claim forms can be obtained from the playgrounds or from our office.

BOOKING POLICIES

RESERVATION POLICIES

1. Reservation must be requested 5 working days in advance.
2. Reservations accepted Mon-Fri from 8:30 am thru 4:30 pm.

RULES AND REGULATIONS:

1. Profit-making functions not allowed except for JPRD or playground booster functions or sanctioned events.
2. No publicity, tickets, or invitations can be issued until reservation application and publicity is approved by JPRD.
3. We reserve the right to:
 - Pre-empt any activity for a JPRD function and will attempt to notify you as far in advance as possible.
 - Cancel any previously confirmed booking for violation of these rules.
4. All JPRD facilities are SMOKE FREE.

CANCELLATIONS:

1. Must be requested, in writing, 10 working days in advance - \$20 fee charged.
2. No mechanical or live animal rides; no water play equipment (such as water slides, slip-n-slides, etc.)
2. Liability coverage (minimum of \$1 million required for Space Walks and/or other such apparatus.
3. No boiling of seafood. Debris must be put into dumpster or trash cans. No boiled seafood for indoor reservations.

BEVERAGES:

1. No glass containers allowed.
2. Any function consuming alcohol or having a large number of people will be required to have a Jefferson Parish deputy on duty. Arrangements will be made at the time of the reservation.





STARSM Puppy Class

(Ages 15 to Adult) **For Pups 3 1/2 to 7 Months Old.** Train your pup in the new "AKC STARSM Puppy Program for mixed breeds and pure-bred dogs. Taught by an AKC certified CGCSM evaluator. Covers socialization, training, activity, and responsible dog ownership. Learn how to teach your pup to walk on a leash, not to jump on guests, to sit & lie down on command and to come when called. Course covers grooming tips, including getting your pup accustomed to having ears and teeth cleaned and nails trimmed. Get your pup off to a good start by learning how to prevent behavior problems and qualify for an AKC STARSM Puppy Certificate and medallion. **First class - owners only** - Bring notebook and pup's record of vaccinations & worming. 
